## OUR PURPOSE

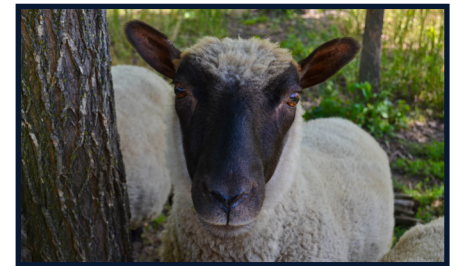

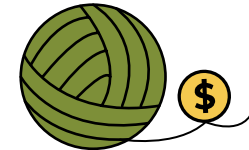

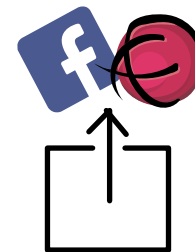


## HOW IT WORKS
