

MAGGIE'S RAGS™

Ruffles Sweater and Hat

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Ruffles adorn this easy to knit sweater and hat set for big and little girls. Shown in size 5/6 in Lorna's Laces Shepherd Worsted (100% superwash wool), color Happy Valley.

Gauge: 20 sts and 30 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch

Needles For Sweater:

- #7 (4.5 mm)- 24" circular, or size needed to achieve proper gauge
- A set of double pointed needles in same size
- Optional: you may find additional longer and shorter circular needles in the same size convenient to use for ruffles, sleeves and neckband

Needles For Hat:

- #7 (4.5 mm) needle, or size needed to achieve proper gauge. For size small: Set of dp needles
For sizes medium & large: 16" circular or a set of dp needles
- Optional: you may find an additional longer circular needle convenient to use for the ruffle
- Crochet hook same size as needles



MATERIALS

Worsted weight yarn, approx. 225 yards/4 oz (90 meters/50 grams) - about 13 wraps per inch

RUFFLES SWEATER

Using circular needle CO ____. Join beginning and end of cast on row, being careful not to twist knitting. Mark beginning of round. Work circularly in Chinese Waves (see p. 4 for instructions) for 10 rounds.	120 sts	132 sts	144 sts	156 sts	168 sts	180 sts

Sleeves						
Using double pointed needles and a new ball of yarn, CO _____. Divide stitches between 3 needles and join beginning and end of cast on row, being careful not to twist knitting. Mark first st of round. Work circularly in Chinese Waves for 10 rounds.	36 sts	36 sts	36 sts	48 sts	48 sts	48 sts
Knit 3 rounds. Purl 1 round.

Neckband (All Sizes): Using double pointed needles, work 10 rounds in Chinese Waves. Knit 4 rounds. Bind off loosely. Fold neckband to inside and sew down loosely.

Ruffles: Make a ruffle in each purl round, at bottom of sleeves and in sweater yoke, as follows. Using circular needle and working along stitches on purl round, knit up one stitch in each purl stitch around sweater.
Working circularly, *K1, YO*. Repeat between * around.
Repeat this round once more. Note: If your needle becomes uncomfortably full, you may wish to use a longer circular needle, or to divide your knitting between two circular needles to make more room.
Bind Off Round: K1 *YO, PSO, K1, PSO*. Repeat between * around until all sts have been bound off.

Finishing

Weave body and sleeves together at underarms, using long tails of yarn left from sleeves. Weave in loose ends

RUFFLES HAT

	Small	Medium	Large
Cast on ____ stitches, using dp needles for size small or a 16" circular needle for sizes medium and large. Join beginning and end of cast on row, being careful not to twist knitting. Mark beginning of round.	68 sts	80 sts	96 sts
Bottom Band: Work circularly in Chinese Waves for 10 rounds.			
Knit 3 rounds. Purl 1 round. Work even in knitting until hat measures ____ from cast on.	6½" (16 cm)	8" (20 cm)	10½" (26 cm)
Make eyelets: *YO, K2tog*. Repeat between * around.			
Work even in knitting for another 2" (5 cm). Bind off in knitting.			
String Tie: Using a double strand of yarn and crochet hook, chain stitch 18" (45 cm). Cut yarn and weave ends in. Lace the string through the eyelets at the top of the hat, pull up tight and tie in a bow.			
Ruffle: Work ruffle in purl round at bottom of hat as for sweater. You may find it convenient to switch to a longer circular needle if your needle becomes uncomfortably full.			
Finishing: Weave in ends.			

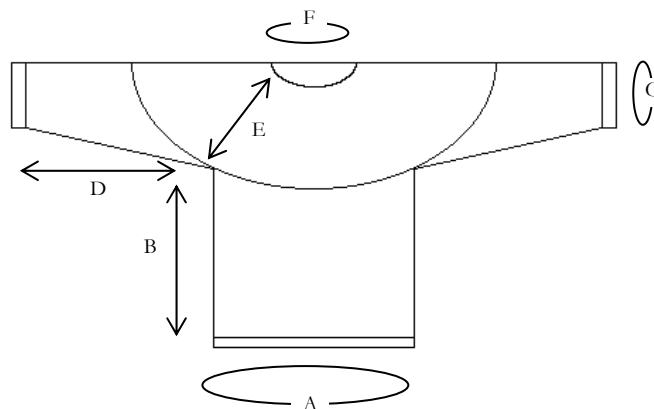

- Round 1: *P1, Sl1 purlwise with yarn in front of work*. Repeat between * around.
- Round 2: Knit
- Round 3: *Sl1 purlwise with yarn in front of work, P1*. Repeat between * around.
- Round 4: Knit
