## Babes & Tots Challenge - Patterns Recommendations

I've made available a number of my knitting patterns for babies and toddlers. Some of the patterns include sizing for older children as well, although those sizes don't qualify for this challenge. Be sure to stick to baby and toddler sizes. They include sweaters, blankets, hats and socks. Here are some highlights.

Grow as You Go Sweater	Sweater worked from cuff to cuff is designed to expand to fit multiple sizes
	so the child can wear it longer.
Ruffles Sweater & Hat,	Two separate patterns to make a circular yoked sweater, a drawstring hat,
matching Ruffles Socks	and socks, all embellished with ruffles.
Trumpet Vine Baby Set	Cross-front sweater and hat with a simple lace pattern.
Wiggle Worms Baby Set	Hat, cross-front sweater, and booties, work in seed stitch with snake cables.
Baby Oliva Cardigan &	Two separate patterns, using the same pattern stitches.
Blanket	
Seashore Hat, Sweater &	Circular yoked sweater, stocking cap, and socks, all using the same stranded
Socks	motifs.
Baby Clair Sweater	Cute textured sweater that looks great in variegated, heathered, or solid
	yarns.

There are many other great patterns out there, but a good choice is anything from Tin Can Knits, especially their "Simple Collection" that includes hats, sweaters, socks, mittens, and blankets. All the patterns in it are free and can be accessed through their app or by downloading a PDF. https://tincanknits.com/collection/the-simple-collection

- I used the instructions in Elizabeth Zimmerman's *Knitter's Almanac* for the leggings for my own children.
