The Craft Yarn Council of America (CYCA) has sizing standards for designers to use. You can find them here:

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the World Health Organization (WHO) also have measurement data, but it's limited to age, height/length, weight, and head circumference, so is of limited us for figuring out garment sizes (except hats).

ASTM International (formerly American Society for Testing and Materials) sets standards for business and industry to use in almost everything imaginable. Arm Length: measure from armhole seam to wrist
Cervical to Back Waist: measure from back of neck at neckline down back to waistline
Waist Height: measure from waist to soles of feet
